This stunning new community and library building at Southmere has a number of different spaces to hire.

The community space is located on the mezzanine and first floors. It has a number of flexible areas to hire from hot desking, an enterprise zone, a health room and multiple meeting rooms. There is also a large event space with access to an outside terrace area overlooking Southmere Lake that can hold up to 100 people. It's ideal for large events, including celebrations, corporate events, and fitness sessions. All spaces also have access to a kitchen area and come with tables and chairs.

Located in The Moorings, the Jubilee Community Centre can hold up to 60 people and has a small outside seated area which you may find useful during the warmer months. The community centre itself comes with tables, chairs and kitchen facilities, and its floor to ceiling windows let in lots of natural light. This venue is suitable for small gatherings and community groups. Based in Birchmere Park, the community hub is surrounded by lots of greenery and is ideal for community groups to meet, as well as small celebrations such as children's parties and birthday celebrations. This hub is enclosed by fencing and has a small grassed area. It can hold up to 40 people and comes with tables, chairs and access to a kitchen area.

This newly refurbished building is located in The Moorings and has a number of spaces for hire. These include a large hall with staging and lighting that can hold 100 people, and would be perfect for performances, social gatherings and events. The building also offers a number of flexible spaces that would be great for community groups and small activities which can accommodate between 15-20 people.

There's a café located on the first floor and space available to read, play board games or simply sit and relax. All spaces come with tables, chairs and access to IT equipment. Sporting Club Thamesmead offers sport and fitness activities, function rooms for hire, a sports bar, spaces for children's parties, and more.

It was opened in 2013, with the help of funding from the Football Foundation and other contributors, and is home to many football and sports clubs as well as being available to the whole community. Facilities for hire include a state of the art 3G artificial football pitch, stadium and grass pitches, a multi-games area, a fitness studio and function rooms. There is also a licensed bar which is available for functions from 7pm - 11pm. The rooms can hold up to 150 people and are perfect for training events and larger gatherings.

This is one of the larger spaces available to hire in Thamesmead. It's a mirrored sports hall that's perfect for dance classes and other physical activities like yoga, ballet and aerobics.

The space is flexible and can be used for many activities with access to a small changing area. There is also a kitchen available for those who need an area to prepare and cook food. The space can hold 60 people and comes with tables and chairs. Broadwater Hub is located in West Thamesmead. It's an ideal space for community groups to meet up, and for small celebrations such as children's parties, baby showers and other special occasions. The hall can hold up to 40 people and comes with tables, chairs, and access to a kitchen area for those who need to prepare or cook food. There is a small outdoor area complete with artificial grass. It's also equipped with tables and benches, and is a great space to use during the warmer months.

It also has access to a community garden, which has been developed and maintained by local residents, as well as a kitchen area. The Link is a stunning youth and community centre made up of eight arches located under the Harrow Manor Way flyover near Southmere Lake.

It is occupied by our partner organisations who offer a range of youth services and activities. These include opportunities for: singing, acting, dancing, a fitness gym, motorcycle workshops and film nights in an exciting, safe, and welcoming place.

The main studio offers a spacious 160-seat performance space in a flexible theatre format. It also features all the latest technology, making it perfect for artistic performances, rehearsals, conferences, presentations, seminars, and workshops.
